Finalists from three divisions (up to 6 years old, 7-11, and 12-18) will be chosen by the Library, and winners will be selected by a community vote to have their bookmarks printed and distributed during the Summer Library Challenge in June.

Contest Rules

Design your bookmark in this space

- Each entry must be the original work of one person.
- Any 2D art medium may be used, including digital art. Digital art must be less than 10MB and either (a) 300 dpi and 750 pixels by 1950 pixels or (b) 600 dpi and 1500 pixels by 3900 pixels. Files must be JPGs or PNGs. 3D materials will not be accepted.
- Designs that incorporate copyrighted or trademarked characters, art, logos, and similar will not be accepted.
- Please do not include your name in the bookmark design.
- This form must be submitted in whole with the rules, bookmark design, personal information, and parent/guardian's signature.
- The contest will run from January 3 to February 28 and is open to children ages 0 to 18 in the greater St. Helens area. All entries are due by 7pm on Monday, February 28. Entries must be submitted at the checkout desk or emailed to shpl@sthelensoregon.gov.
- Finalists from three age divisions (0 to 6, 7 to 11, and 12 to 18) will be selected by the library based on design and reproducibility.
- Winners will be selected by a community vote in March and/or April. Winners will be notified before the end of April. Bookmarks will be printed and will be released in conjunction with the launch of the Summer Library Challenge in June.
